

Ronald McDonald House Expectations and Rules

1. The patient must be receiving medically necessary ongoing care (generally 2-3 appointments per week). We may ask for a copy of your appointment schedule during your guest stay.
2. Families are expected to clean up after using **any** public area (i.e. Kitchens, Game Room, Playrooms, Great Rooms). Your cooperation in loading and unloading the dishwasher, putting away food, wiping off counters and stoves, emptying trash, picking up toys, etc. is necessary and expected.
3. Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM everyday. This includes the public areas and your guest room. Please remember you have neighbors around, above and below you. Also, all visitors must leave by 9:00 pm.
4. **No smoking** is allowed in the House or on the House grounds.
5. Please be respectful of all guests, volunteers and staff at the Ronald McDonald House. Courtesy is expected of everyone in the House.
6. No discriminatory, unsafe, disrespectful, disruptive, abusive, offensive, suggestive, sexual or illegal behavior will be tolerated.
7. No alcohol or illegal drugs are allowed on the premises.
8. No firearms, knives or other weapons are allowed on the premises.
9. No open flames (candles, incense, matches, lighters, etc.) are allowed in the House.
10. Families are expected to clean their guest room before checking out of the House (see House Check Out Procedures in guest room binder).
11. Children must be supervised by a parent or guardian at all times. **Please note that Other Guest Families, Volunteers, or Staff Members are NOT allowed to watch your children.**
